



Attention all Medicare Beneficiaries...

Beginning January 1, 2014, your Medicare benefit for Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy will have the following restrictions:

- **Physical and Speech Therapy combined \$1,920**
- **Occupational Therapy \$1,920**

This is an annual financial limitation per calendar year (January 1 through December 31, 2014) for any outpatient therapy services, including hospital-based outpatient facility therapy services.

Any therapy you have received for this condition or another condition may apply to this limitation. In order to assist you in knowing if you have met your limitation, please inform our staff of any therapy you received during the year, beginning January 1, 2014 by any therapy provider.

If you require skilled therapy services beyond this dollar amount, your therapist can discuss options with you.

In addition, Medicare has an annual Part B deductible of \$147 for 2014. If you have either a Medicare supplement or a secondary insurance plan, it may or may not cover this deductible. We will bill all insurance plans you have identified and should your insurance not cover the deductible, we will bill you for any remaining balance once your claim has been considered for payment.
